



Promoting your events/courses through NZANLP

All current Associate and Professional Members of NZANLP, have the opportunity to promote their events/courses through the NZANLP network free of charge.

Listings do not need to be specifically NLP focused and we welcome events/courses that would be of interest to the broader community of individuals involved with NLP either on a professional or personal level.

Friends and non-members of NZANLP may also promote their events/courses, however, they will incur a charge of \$25 per listing.

Website

Event listings appear on the NZANLP website in two places:

1. At the end of the home page: <http://www.nzanlp.org.nz>
2. On the events page: <http://www.nzanlp.org.nz/events-list>

Events appear in a thumbnail on both of these pages.

When the user hovers their mouse over, more information appears.

By clicking on the "More details" button, the full event listing displays.

The following information is required for a listing:

1. Event title
2. An email or URL for bookings
3. Date(s)
4. Start and finish time
5. Location (address and venue name if applicable)
6. An image in landscape format (please note that this is automatically cropped into square format for the thumbnail)
7. Information about the event (this can include information about the event as well as information about the presenters)
